Website category

- Submit your Weebly URL with your entry information
- If you do not submit the Weebly URL we cannot send your website to the judges
- Website lockout will take place on April 4, 2017
- **Please make sure to publish your website before the lockout date.**

Websites can not be unlocked for any reason after the lockout date



Documentary category

- Submit your final entry by April 4, 2017
You will receive a link to the NYHD SmugMug room on Thursday, March 30, 2017.
You must upload your final entry by April 4, 2017.
- Four printed copies of your process paper and bibliography must be sent to the New York State History Day and postmarked by April 4, 2017. (Please note that the papers will not be returned.)
