

Museum of the City of New York GIS Apprenticeship

The Museum is riding an exciting wave of success and is in the midst of a revitalization of its mission and operations, which centers on the renovation and expansion of its historic building, the advancement of the stewardship of its collections, and new and ambitious exhibitions, publications, and public and school programs.

The Museum seeks a Geographic Information Systems Apprentice to assist the Curatorial team on the development of maps for the Future City Lab, which opened in November 2016 as part of the permanent exhibition *New York at Its Core*. This is an ideal internship for someone who wishes to develop GIS skills and apply them to a project with wide visibility, as the apprentice will receive training in the use of GIS software and analysis. The apprentice will be working on the development of new maps and updates to existing maps for the Future City Lab's large *Mapping NYC: 2000-2050* display, and will work with the Lab's Director and the Museum's mapping consultants at the Pratt institute's Spatial Analysis and Visualization Initiative. During the course of this internship, the apprentice will develop expertise in acquiring and formatting data from the U.S. Census and other sources and performing mapping and analysis using the ArcGIS® and Carto® platforms. Prior experience with GIS is a plus but not necessary.

Candidates should have working knowledge of Excel, and must possess excellent data management and quantitative skills. Because the position involves training on the part of Museum staff, we ask for a minimum of a six month commitment.

This is an unpaid, part-time internship position. Hours and schedule flexible.
